



To achieve our mission of “positively impacting New Yorkers through credit unions,” the New York Credit Union Foundation provides financial support through three grant programs. These grant programs have been redesigned for 2023 to better meet the evolving needs of the New York credit union community, and they wouldn’t be possible without your support!

Professional Development Grants enable credit union employees and volunteers to attend education and training programs sponsored by the New York Credit Union Association. Grant limit is \$2,500 per calendar year, per credit union.

IMPACT Grants help fund credit union initiatives in a variety of areas such as technology enhancements, security upgrades, consulting services such as strategic planning, and efforts to support emerging and underrepresented markets, including youth, older Americans, immigrant populations and people of low or modest means. Grant limit is \$5,000 per calendar year, per credit union.

Disaster Relief Grants are awarded to credit unions, employees, volunteers and members who have been impacted by unforeseen disasters. This grant program is enacted on an emergency or as-needed basis. In recent years, hundreds of credit unions and individuals have used these grants to help rebuild after natural disasters.

Grant Limits and Eligibility Requirements

The grant limits outlined above are subject to modification at any time and are contingent upon the availability of funds. All federal and state-chartered credit unions located in New York State, along with their employees or volunteers, are eligible to apply. Applicants must be able to demonstrate financial need as a requirement for any grant program. The total amount of a grant award will vary for members and non-members of the New York Credit Union Association.
